Sea stars, or starfish, are actually related to sand dollars and sea urchins, not fish.

Sea stars can grow new arms if they lose one, say, to a fish bite.

Most sea stars have 5 arms but others have up to 40 arms!

Sea stars eat shellfish like clams and oysters.



Seahorses are a type of fish that like to live in coral reefs and sea grass where they can easily hide.

Even though they live in the ocean, they are not very good swimmers.

Seahorses are small animals that can be anywhere from one inch to one foot long.

Seahorses eat by sucking food up their horse-like snout.

Sea Turtles live in all the oceans except for the Arctic. There are 7 living species of sea turtles all of which are endangered.

They can live to be 80 years old!

Sea turtles must come to the ocean surface to breathe but some turtles can hold their breath for hours while they swim and hunt for food like jellyfish.
